What do I need to graduate?

- You need 30 credits total ([What Do I Need To Graduate?](#))
- On the Summary of Student Achievement sheet (page 2 of personal handout), your total credits are listed at the very bottom (this includes semester 1 credits)
- In the middle section under 'Transcript Credits' the 'Remaining' column will remind you which compulsory credits you still need

In Grade 12, what MUST I take?

You need to choose 6-8 course total including:

- ENG4U or ENG4C (and your appropriate ESL courses if needed) *
- 1 Christian Perspectives Course (next slide)

*unless you have already taken for some reason

some students may have one or two spares but you must ensure you will have enough credits to graduate and have what you need for college and university

What electives should I choose?

To make up the rest of your courses, you can choose:

- Grade 12 electives that you need for college or university
- Use <http://electronicinfo.ca>, <https://www.ontariocolleges.ca/en/> and <https://app.myblueprint.ca> to research university requirements for your program of interest
- You must take at least 6 Grade 12 U/M courses in order to apply to university
- If you have enough Grade 12 U/M courses, you may take grade 11 courses

Music and Art 12 (need grade 11) *photography and illustrations 12 too!

Comm Tech 12 (need grade 11)

Literature Studies 12 (need ENG3U)

Sciences 12 (need Chem, Bio or Physics 12 respectively)

Grade 12 Courses Needing grade 11 prerequisites continued

French 12 (need grade 12)

Computer Science 12 (need grade 11)

Social Sciences/Can and World Studies 12 (need grade 11U/M Soc Sci, Can studies or English)

Intro to Kinesiology 12 (need grade 11 science or PE)

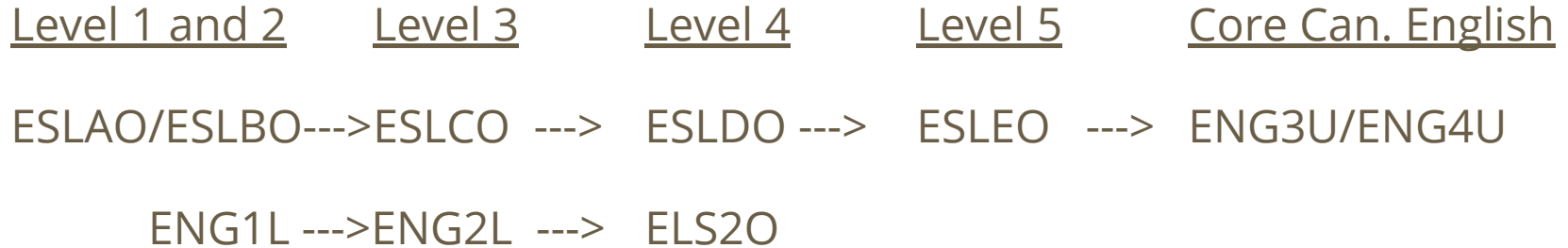
Extras - don't forget!

- Follow the correct math pathway and ask Miss Peters if you are not sure
- If you failed or missed something from grade 9 ,10, or 11, add it in (write somewhere on the form)
 - You should have taken gr 9 (English, Math, Science, Geography, Art/Music, French, PE)
 - You should have taken gr 10 (English, Math, Science, History, Civics/Careers)
 - You should have taken gr 11 (English, Math)

Typical ESL pathway

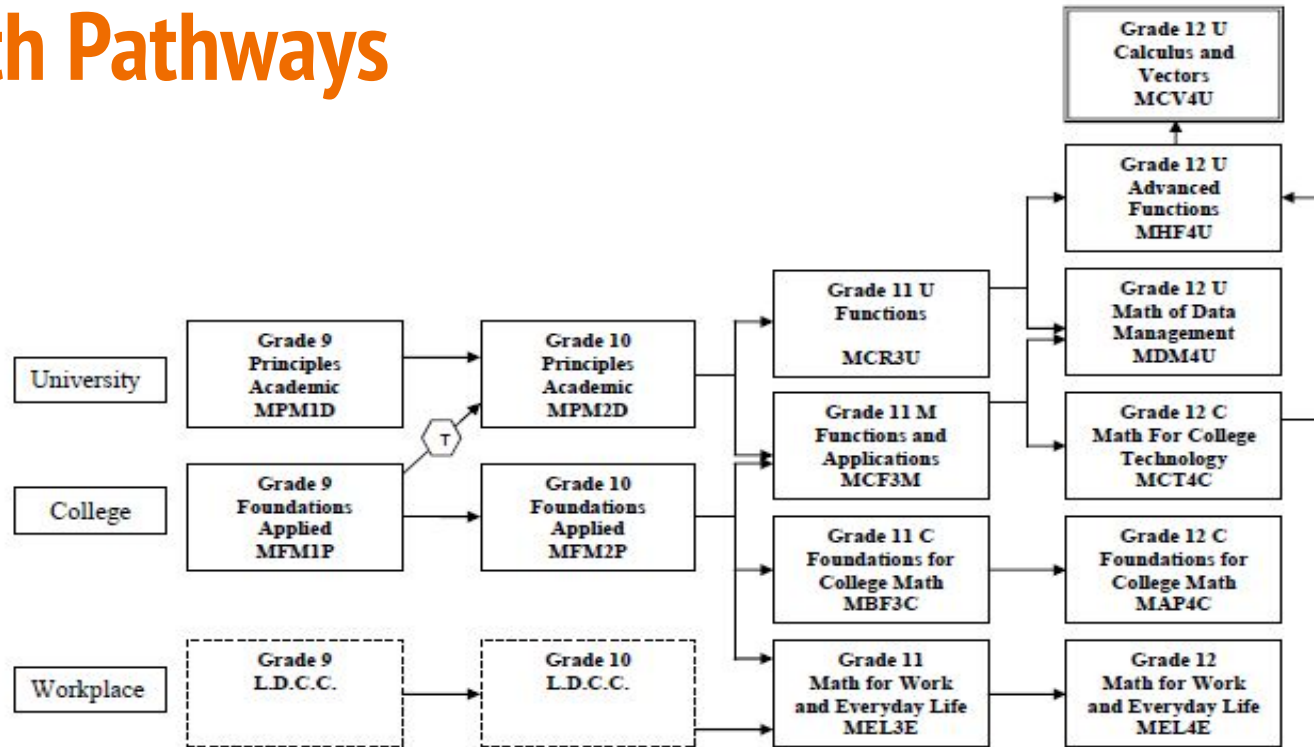
Most students will move through **one** ESL level per year.

Math Pathways



What should I take in gr. 12?

You will need at least 6 grade 12 U/M courses for university consideration

Engineering

ENG4U, Chem 12 U, Physics 12 U, MCV4U and MHF4U, Electives like Computer Science, Business, Comm Tech etc.

Biology/Life Sciences

ENG4U, MHF4U and possibly MCV4U, Chem 12 U, Bio 12 U (possibly Physics 12 U)

Social Sciences (Sociology, Psychology, etc.)

ENG4U, MDM4U or MHF4U or none, Electives like World Issues, Families, Business, History, Geo, Econ, etc.

Business/Commerce

ENG4U, MHF4U and MCV4U is best (or MHF4U and MDM4U if necessary), Electives like Accounting, Economics, etc.

Visual Arts or Music

ENG4U, Art 12, Photography/Illustrations or Music 12, Keyboarding 12, Math 12 may be necessary for design programs,

College Programs

ENG4U or ENG4C, Math 12 C depending on your program of interest; sometimes sciences are needed
