

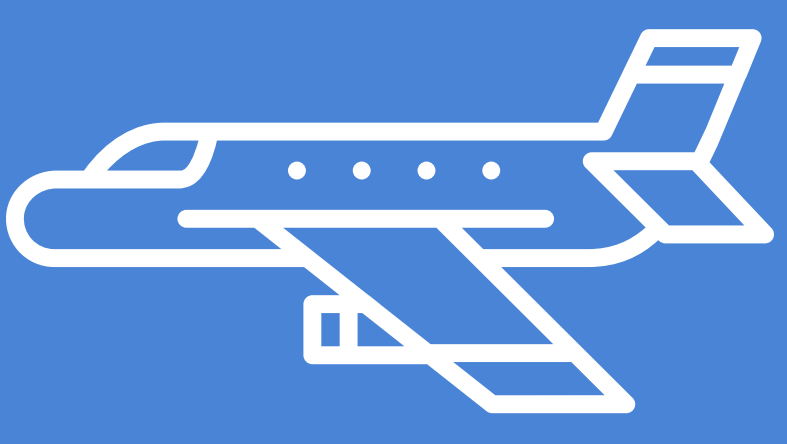


Supporting International Students Arriving to Ontario



In accordance with the Government of Canada's Quarantine Act, all international student travellers must quarantine (self-isolate) for 14 days upon arrival into Canada.

NCC will be planning for, organizing, and supervising a 14-day quarantine, for all students travelling internationally to Ontario. The following details our layered approach to safety.



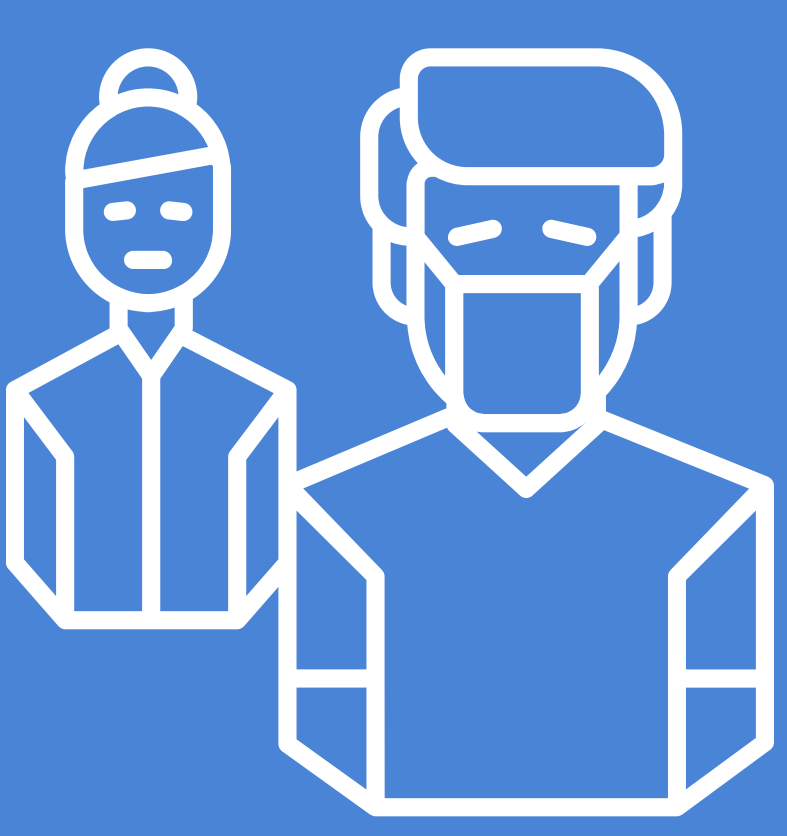
Pre-arrival and Arriving in Canada

- International students/families are encouraged to download the ArriveCAN app before arrival in Canada.
- Students should expect to be COVID-screened at the airport as part of the immigration process.
- A representative from NCC will meet students at the arrival gate and bring them directly to their transportation.
- Students will be driven directly to their accommodations.
- All drivers and students will be required to wear masks during the trip.



Arriving to Quarantine

- Dorm staff will show students to their rooms where they will be given an orientation specific to the two-week quarantine.
- All staff will be wearing masks and face shields and masks will be required for all students as well.



Accommodations

- Students will be instructed on and provided with supplies to clean high-touch surfaces regularly.
- Students will not be permitted to leave their quarantined area



Meals & Necessities

- Meals will be delivered to students' rooms for breakfast, lunch, and dinner. Any necessities that students require will be picked up by NCC staff and delivered to their rooms.



Cleaning & Safety Protocols

- Cleaning all high touch areas multiple times per day
- Students will be trained in proper hand hygiene and safety protocols.
- Students will be trained in proper masking, physical distancing and other health related training.



Screening, Monitoring, and Sharing Information

- Students will use a COVID screening tool to self-monitor daily.
- Staff will complete daily temperature checks and monitor students for signs of illness.
- Public Health and/or all necessary authorities will be notified of all compliant issues and any cases of COVID19.
- NCC will publicly communicate outbreak status and any positive cases of COVID-19 via NCC's website.



Bathrooms, Showers, & Laundry

- Students will have private access to bathrooms, showers, and laundry facilities.
- Students will be trained to properly clean these areas.



Academics

- The Student Services department will contact each new student to facilitate course selection and academic orientation.
- Teachers will facilitate connection and live interaction for the quarantine period after which time students will join the class in person.
- Students will use Edsby to access and submit course work and assignments.
- Class attendance will be taken daily for remote learners.



Physical, Social, & Mental Wellbeing

- Staff will ensure that students are able to engage in activity, and exercise, while respecting the rules for isolation.
- Health Centre support will be available to any student who requires physical or mental health support.
- Students will be given regular training about COVID 19 including the promotion of accuracy and anti stigma based messaging.



Supervision

- Staff will be actively monitoring students to ensure they are healthy, safe, and engaged in their school work during academic hours.



Provincial/Federal Guidelines

- NCC will look for all federal and provincial guidelines and ensure continued compliance. This includes Ontario's Plan for Reopening.
